

S.S. "STYLIANOS COUTSODONTIS"

The 2nd S.S.No.3, due 3,31, has been partly held, and complete same all Rule requirements remain to be complied with except the examination of the rudder, steering gear, chain cables and chain locker. Damage through collision and stranding requires to be repaired.

The vessel is laid up at Salonica, and the usual undertaking has been furnished. R

A letter has now been received from Messrs. Michalinos Co. stating that it is desired to sell the vessel for breaking up purposes in Italy, and they desire that she might proceed there without any repairs being effected.

It is submitted that provided the vessel be generally examined in accordance with the requirements of Circular No. 1605, she might be allowed to proceed to Italy for the purpose of being broken up.
