This ship is still at Salonica. We intend, on Mr. Goutsodontis, to sell her for delivery to ship-breakers, or for scrap metal, in Italy. We should be pleased if you would let us know what we shall be in order in arranging for the ship to be sent to Italy, as she now is, for Italy, or in other words, leaving any repairs of any kind done to her before she leaves. We should be pleased to know, from what Mr. Oxford, of the Piraeus, reported on the subject last year, that the ship certainly could leave Salonica in her present condition for breaking-up port without having any repairs done to her, and we would add that Mr. Oxford's report upon the subject is as under:-

"I may say that in my opinion no further temporary repairs are required to enable the vessel to proceed to a port of refuge, but I must point out that the Committee agreed to the


loading a cargo for Salonica on the understanding that
