With reference to my letter of the 27th April last and previous correspondence relative to the steamer "STYLIANOS COUTSODONTIS" I have to acquaint you I am in receipt of a communication from the Society's Piraeus Surveyors from which it appears that this vessel is still laid up at Salonica.

As over two years have now elapsed since the 2nd Special Survey No.3 became due and the vessel is still laid up indefinitely, the Committee must ask the Owners to arrange for a general examination of the vessel to be held in order to entitle her to retain her class in the Society's Register Book.
