The 2nd S.S.No.3, due 3,31, has been partly held, and to complete same all the Rule requirements remain to be complied with except the examination of the rudder, steering gear, chain cables and chain locker.

Damage through collision and stranding requires to be repaired.

The year of grace expired 3,32, and the vessel is laid up at Monaca.

On 7th ultimo the Owners' Agents in this Country were informed that the Committee were not prepared to grant any further extension, and must require the outstanding items of the Special Survey and all repairs to be carried out before the vessel again sails for Greece.

A letter has now been received from the Agents to the effect that as soon as there are any promising signs of improvement the demand for shipping the Owner will put the vessel through the outstanding surveys.

The case is submitted for the consideration of the Committee.
