S.S. "STYLIANOS COUTSODONTIS".

I beg to advise you that the report of the damage sustained
Nos. 1 and 2 holds of the above steamer through stranding
point on the 28th May 1932 has been handed to Messrs.
Henderson, Lloyd's Agents, Piraeus.

I may say that in my opinion no further temporary repairs
are required to enable the vessel to proceed to a port of repair
I point out that the Committee agreed to the vessel loading
Salonica on the understanding that the remaining items
of Special Survey No. 3 would be carried out without fail on
return to Greece. Should you desire that the vessel load
be allowed to go, with a view to returning to the United Kingdom or
to carry out the damage repairs and complete the Special
Survey, it would require to obtain the Committee's sanction for the
said voyage.

I may add that in the event of the Committee being agreeable
a loading certificate could be granted to enable her to load dry
cargo for the voyage.
