Dear Sir.

In reply to your letter of February 6th 1923 regarding Genoa First Entry Report No 8307 for the S.S. "Superga" we have to state that Ing. Cerruti, of Riva Trigoso has been communicated with and replies as follows:-

1. The fore-castle and poop decks are 75^m/m as approved.

We are of the opinion that this represents the thickness of the rough wood previous to fitting and clearing up. Measured from the top of waterway angle to top of wood deck the thickness is 51^m/m, which makes the deck 66^m/m. It is quite possible however that the deck has been trimmed down a good deal in way of the waterway angle and that the thickness at centre is as approved.

2. On receipt of your previous letter Ing. Cerruti was spoken to regarding the propeller post, but I am afraid there was a misunderstanding. Ing. Cerruti now states that the post is 238x194^m/m. The entry in the Report is an apparent clerical error which was unfortunately not noticed previously.
