The scantlings are in accordance with the Society's Rules for a working pressure of 180 Lbs per square inch and the workmanship is good . - The boilers having been tested in my presence on the 27th May and 6th June 1922 by hydraulic pressure to 320 Lbs per square inch, showed no signs of weakness and were found tight and sound in every respect at that pressure . -

Working pressure not to exceed ONE HUNDRED AND EIGHTY Lbs per square inch . -
