The Second Special Survey No.3 became due on this vessel in September, 1934, and action has been deferred by the Classing Committee from time to time owing to the vessel being laid up in South America.

The vessel was recently purchased from the Argentine Government by the Italian Government for use as an East African transport. She sailed from the Argentine on a certificate issued by the Registro Italiano Surveyor, and from advices received from the Genoa Office it appears that the Society's Class is not required.

The Classing Committee had the case before them on Friday, the 30th ultimo, when in all the circumstances they decided to give instructions for the vessel's character to be withdrawn from the Register Book and three dots (...) inserted in lieu thereof, indicating withdrawal of class at Owners' request.
