

S. S. "BAHIA BLANCA" Not classed.

This steamer was built at Hamburg in 1912, she is now noted as the property of the Argentine Government.

The Buenos Aires Surveyors state that the Owners desire to have the vessel classed, and the Surveyors wish to be informed of what would be required for classification.

The vessel was surveyed by the Buenos Aires Surveyors in December 1918 and the Committee approved of a note "G.L.B.As. 12.18" being inserted in the Register Book at that time.

It is submitted the Buenos Aires Surveyors be informed that before this vessel can be considered for classification, it is necessary to have information regarding her scantlings, and plans of midship section and profile of the Steamer ^{Boilers & particulars of the Engines} should be forwarded to this Office ^{as an arrangement} in order that the scantlings and arrangements shown thereon may be compared with the Rule requirements. Should these be found in order, the steamer should be surveyed for condition and verification of the information given on the plans as required by Section 48 of the Rules.

The vessel has at no time been classed with this Society and there is no further information regarding her in this Office than is given in the Buenos Aires Surveyors' Reports No. 5989 December 1918.
