

This vessel was built in 1912 and classed with the Germanischer Lloyds.

Notation of B.As.12.18 has been assigned.

The Buenos Aires Surveyors now state this vessel has not left the port and docks of Buenos Aires since her arrival with her engines damaged, except for a few hours machinery trial in the River, and that although the question of the right of the vessel to sail under the Argentine Flag has been under consideration since the time of their report, the question has not yet been decided between the Argentine Government and the Great Powers and it has now become a Test Case.

It is submitted no action is necessary.
