This vessel was built in 1912 and classed with Germanischer Lloyd.

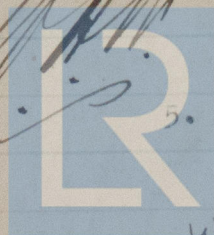
In May last the Bahia Blanca Surveyor reported the vessel had been examined in dry dock and minor repairs effected.

The Buenos Aires Surveyors now report the vessel has been examined generally afloat, as far as practicable, and minor repairs carried out.

The vessel has been laid up for four years and is, so far as seen, in good order throughout.
