With reference to the case of the steamer "SKAGERAK", I beg to acquaint you that the Committee have now had before them the report of the inspection recently made of this vessel by the Society's Surveyors at Sunderland, as a result of which they have given instructions for a notation of "Examined L.R. 6.40" to be made against the vessel's name in the Register Book, to indicate that the vessel has been surveyed by the Surveyors to this Society and that from the parts now seen they are of opinion that she is in a fit condition to trade for a period of six months from the date of examination.

I think it well to add for your information, that the boilers and screwshaft have also been examined on the present occasion with satisfactory results.
