## Lloyd's Register of Shipping,

Dear Sirs,

I beg to acquaint you that the contents of your letter of yesterday's date regarding the ex Danish steamer "SKAGERAK" were telephoned here from our London Office this morning, and full instructions in the matter have been sent to the Society's Surveyors at Sunderland, both with a view to the issue of British Freeboard Certificates and also with a view to the vessel being generally examined, to enable a special record of "Examined L.R. (with date)" to be inserted in the Register Book, indicative of the fact that the steamer which was formerly classed by another Register, has now been surveyed by the Surveyors to Lloyd's Register and found or placed in an efficient condition to trade for a period of six months.

I may add that this procedure has already received the approval of the Ministry of Shipping, and I trust it will commend itself to you.
