S. I have to acquaint you the Springwell Shipping Co. Ltd. state that the Danish steamer "SKAGERAK", No. 33810, at present lying at your Port, has been handed over to them by the Ministry of Shipping for management and that the Society's class is desired.

With regard thereto, I have to request that you will be guided by the instructions contained in my letter of today's date, setting forth the procedure to be adopted, both for maintenance and freeboard in cases of Danish vessels which were formerly classed either with the Germanischer Lloyd or Norske Veritas.

You should accordingly endeavour to arrange for the requisite General Examination to be held and for the Danish Freeboard Certificates and Surveys Book to be sent to this Office as soon as possible.
