Dear Sirs,

With reference to your First Entry Report No.10374 on the machinery of the new steamer "BRETWALDA", I have to inform you that the usual First Entry and Classification fees should be charged to the Builders, viz:-

First Entry.....£ 3. 0. 0.
Survey fee.....£45.18. 0.

In addition to these fees there will be an amount chargeable to the Department of the Controller General of Merchant Shipbuilding, of 50% of the difference between the fees as a standard vessel at 1/4 per ton and the rule fees, and an account has accordingly been rendered from this Office to the Department of the Controller General of Merchant Shipbuilding for the sum of £34.


The above fees have been entered on your First Entry Report and you will be good enough to see that the necessary entries are now made in your Rough Fee and Debit Books, and render an account to the Builders for the Classification fees chargeable to them.
