Dear Sir,

We are forwarding to-day the first entry report on the hull of the steamer "BRETWALDA" also Middlesbrough Report No. 10374 on the machinery of this vessel and shall be glad to know the amount of fees that are to be charged in this case.

As stated in our letter to you of the 2nd April this vessel was taken over by the Builders sometime after we had signed the 2nd claim on 23rd December 1918 and with the actual tonnages the fees would work out for the hull as follows:-

Gross tons 5293 at  $1\frac{1}{4} \times \frac{2}{3} = £235 : 4 : 11 \times \frac{1}{2} = £117:12: 5$

Tonnage for fees 5056 = (£151:8:0 + £5 entry fee)  $\times \frac{1}{2} = 78: 4: 0$

Proportion of fee due by Controller = £ 39: 8: 5

If the machinery fee is calculated in the same way it would be:-

Gross tons 5293 at  $1\frac{1}{4} \times \frac{1}{3} = £117:12: 5 \times \frac{1}{2} = £58:16: 3$

N.H.P. 518 = (£45:18: 0 + £3 entry fee)  $\times \frac{1}{2} = 24: 9: 0$

Proportion of fee due by Controller = £34: 7: 3
