Dear Sir,

With reference to the screw steamer "BRYNOLF" N:o 15348 in the Register Book I beg to state that the construction of this vessel was commenced in March 1920 and she was launched in December 1920.

Since the beginning of 1922 work on the vessel has been practically suspended but it is now intended to complete the vessel as soon as possible and in the circumstances the Builders desire to learn if the date of build will be taken as the date of the completion of the special survey as per paragraph 7 of the General Regulations.

The vessel has to-day been examined by me on a slipway and the bottom was found in perfect order.

A general examination of the hull, including the double bottom tanks internally, and of the engines and the boilers has also been carried out and it was found that no deterioration whatever had taken place.

The ceiling on the tank top in the vessel has not yet been laid.
