The Second Special Survey No.1 became due on this vessel in August, 1934, and in February last a proposal to carry out the Survey within the year of grace was agreed to.

Action was again deferred on the 16th ultimo in view of a proposal to use the vessel as a storage hulk or to sell her for breaking up purposes.

The Owners' Agents now write they have decided to employ the vessel in short river service in the East Indies, where she will trade under a Certificate granted by the Netherlands East Indies Government, and they therefore request that the class may be withdrawn from the Register Book.

The Classing Committee had the case before them on Tuesday, the 3rd instant, when in the circumstances they decided to give instructions for the vessel's character to be withdrawn from the Register Book and three dots (...) inserted in lieu thereof, indicating withdrawal of class at Owners' request.
