

The Boiler Survey became due on this vessel at the end of June last, and on the 2nd ultimo a proposal to hold the survey when the vessel was stopped in about ten days' time was agreed to.

The Society's Surveyor at Boulogne now forwards a letter from the Owners in which they state they wish to discontinue the classification of the trawler with this Society. They add "We avail ourselves of this opportunity of thanking you for the services rendered by you and for the good relations we have always maintained".

The Boulogne Surveyor adds that he was informed by the Owners that they have decided to class the vessel with the Bureau Veritas.

The Classing Committee had the case before them on Friday, the 30th ultimo, when in the circumstances they decided to give instructions for the vessel's character to be withdrawn from the Register Book and three dots (...) inserted in lieu thereof, indicating withdrawal of class at Owners' request.
