The 2nd Special Survey No.1, which became due on the "MOMOHA MARU" in June last, has been held on the machinery, and a proposal to carry out the survey of the hull in February last has been agreed to by the Classing Committee.

The Boiler Survey of the "TENCHO MARU" became due in January last.

In reply to enquiry the Society's Surveyors at Kobe forward a translation of a letter from the Owners intimating that, as these vessels are now employed on restricted service only, it is no longer desired to retain this Society's classification.

The Classing Committee had the cases before them on Friday, 3rd instant, when they decided to give instructions for the character of each vessel to be withdrawn from the Register Book and three dots (...) inserted in lieu thereof, indicating withdrawal of class at Owners' request.
