I have to inform you that the Steel S.S. "LE QUESNOY" is reported to have left Toronto on the 5th December last for New York, where it is proposed to complete the survey, and that in order to do this the decks, tunnel and watertight doors, fore and after peak tanks above the water line, and the bulkheads require to be tested and damage sustained through launching to be repaired.

I shall be glad if the Surveyors will give the case the necessary attention, and on completion of the work to their satisfaction forward a report on Form No. 8 with a view to the classification of the vessel.
