re of Survey

The 2nd S.S. No.2 became due 2,32 and no part of the survey has been held.

The vessel being laid up the Owners have furnished the usual undertaking.

The case received consideration in April last (Special Survey more than 2 years overdue) when a general examination was required.

The Amsterdam Surveyors now report the vessel surveyed afloat and a general examination carried out and found satisfactory except as regards some deck plates in Bridge space and a bottom plate forward bulkhead of deep tank found wasted.

The Surveyors recommend the deep tank be not used as a tank until repaired and the necessary repairs to same and to deck plating be carried out before the vessel is recommissioned.

The pipe line to deep tank has been blanked off.

It is submitted action be deferred.
