The Second Special Survey No. 3 became due on this vessel in January 1934, and no part of the survey has been held.

A proposal to carry out the Special Survey at the end of last month, or the beginning of this was agreed to on the 22nd ultimo, the Committee relying upon the Special Survey being carried out without fail as then stated.

The Belfast Surveyors now forward a letter from the Owner to the effect that it has been decided to class this ship with another Society, and that as from the 7th instant she will be withdrawn from the Society's classification.

The year of grace expired at the end of last month.

The Classing Committee had the case before them on Tuesday, the 12th instant, when, in all the circumstances, it was decided to give instructions for the vessel's character to be expunged from the Register Book with a Red Line (2,35), indicating non-compliance with the Society's Rules, and the Owner has been informed accordingly.
