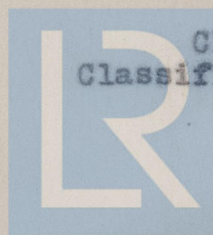
I beg to acquaint you that the Society's Surveyors at Belfast have forwarded to this Office your letter of the 7th instant intimating that it is not your intention to maintain the classification of your steamer "WHITEROCK" in the Society's Register Book.

As you are aware the Second Special Survey No.3 became due on this vessel in January, 1934 and no part of this inspection has been held.

A proposal to complete the survey at the end of January or the beginning of February was agreed to by the Committee so recently as the 22nd ultimo, and as this arrangement has not been carried into effect, they regret they have no alternative but to give instructions for the vessel's class to be expunged from the Register Book with a Red Line, indicating non-compliance with the Society's Rules.
