Dear Sir,

With reference to the classification in this Society's Register Book of the steamer "SUKHONA" and to the Special Annual Boiler Survey, which became due at the end of August last, I beg to remind you that this inspection was partly held at Hamburg in November last and that to complete the same the starboard main boiler and donkey boiler require to be examined in their entirety and the safety valves of these boilers adjusted under steam.

It was understood that the survey would be completed at Hull, whither the vessel proceeded from Hamburg, but this does not appear to have been done. In the circumstances I shall be obliged if you will kindly let me know, in course of post, whether it is your intention to have the inspection completed in order to entitle the vessel to retain her class.
