Dear Sirs,

I beg to acquaint you that the Committee of this Society have had before them a letter received from the Owners of the steamer "DUMONT D'URVILLE" in which they state this vessel is at present laid up at Saigon where the Boiler Survey, which according to the Society's Rules became due at the end of July last, can be carried out.

In view of the fact that the Society has no Surveyor stationed in the vicinity of Saigon, the Committee have decided to ask you to be good enough to appoint a competent and independent Surveyor to hold this inspection on behalf of this Society upon your receiving a request from the Owners, or their Representatives to do so.

For the information of the Surveyor I enclose herewith instructions for carrying out the inspection, together with a form for reporting the survey which should be returned to this Office in due course, and I may say that all fees and expenses in connexion with the matter must be paid by the Owners or their Representatives and should accordingly be charged by you to them.
