S. With reference to my letter of the 27th ultimo, respecting the case of the steamer "MARIE MOLLER", I have to inform you that a cablegram has come to hand from the Society's Surveyors at Kobe, stating that although the vessel docked at Hikoshima, she left again before being surveyed.

In these circumstances the Committee have had no alternative, having regard to the fact that the general examination required has not been carried out, but to give instructions for the vessel's class to be expunged from the Register Book with a Red Line, indicating non-compliance with the Society's Rules.
