The 2nd S.S.No.3 due 4,35 has been partly held, and to complete it the following remains to be done:-

All the Rule requirements to be complied with except the examination of shelter 'tween decks throughout, fore peak space, side and pocket and shelter deck bunkers, deep tank and 'tween deck above, and testing of deep tank.

The shell plating requires to be drilled.



*The survey has been partly held*

A proposal to defer completion of the Survey until April, 1936 was agreed to in view of a satisfactory general examination held in dry dock at Shanghai in October last.

In May last the Owners requested an extension of four to six months for the completion of the Survey, and this was agreed to, subject to a further general examination being carried out by one of the Society's Exclusive Surveyors at a port in the Far East, and to his report being entirely satisfactory.

Mr.Cox, Principal Surveyor for the Far East, was advised and requested to arrange for the matter to receive attention. A cablegram has now been received from him stating that the vessel docked at Hikoshima but has left before being surveyed.

It is a matter for consideration whether the class of the vessel should not now be dealt with.
