Extension of Survey

I have to thank you for your letter under date of yesterday and have communicated the contents to the Shanghai office, asking them to immediately advise us as to where the vessel can be surveyed by your Society. As soon as this is to hand I will let you know.

I regret to see that the Committee are surprised at the statement which I have made regarding the same charter being in force. You will perhaps recall at the time of interview I fully explained to yourselves that this vessel had been fixed on the basis of 'one year option six months'. Now that the charterers have taken up this option it is similar to the original charter continuing. At the original time of the fixture and when the 'temporary survey' was carried out we had been guided that this option would not be used. I fully believe that your society is well enough in touch with shipping matters to know that this is not an unusual practice.

My thanks to your Committee for their consideration.
