S.S. "MARIE MOLLER"



The 2nd S.S.No.3, due 4,35 has been partly held.
To complete the survey all the Rule requirements require to be complied with except the examination of shelter 'tween decks throughout, fore peak space, side and pocket and shelter deck bunkers, deep tank and 'tween deck above, and testing of deep tank. The shell plating requires to be drilled.

A proposal to defer completion of the Special Survey until April, 1936 was agreed to in view of a satisfactory general examination held in dry dock at Shanghai in October last.

A letter has been received from ^{office} ~~Messrs.~~ ^{for Moller (writing from)} Galbraith, Pembroke & Co. requesting that an extension of four to six months may be granted for completion of the survey. It appears that the vessel is on charter and the Owners cannot secure her return until the early Autumn.

The year of grace expired last month.

The case is submitted for the consideration of the Committee.
