The Third Special Survey No.1, which became due on this vessel in January, 1934, was partly held at Grimsby in July last, when the Owners' proposal to complete this inspection within the year of grace, was agreed to.

The vessel came under the survey of the Society's Surveyors at Middlesbrough in January last when a general examination afloat was made.

The Surveyors recommended that the vessel should be chipped throughout for further examination, but were informed by the Owners' Representative that it was not proposed to comply with this recommendation, and that the vessel had proceeded to the Tyne on a Certificate granted by the British Corporation.

In a letter dated the 15th instant, addressed to the Society's Surveyors at Newcastle by the Owners, it was stated that the class of this vessel was being transferred to the British Corporation and that the Society's inspection was not required.

The year of grace expired in January last, and in all the circumstances the Classing Committee, who had the case of this vessel under consideration on Tuesday, the 26th instant, decided to give instructions for the vessel's class to be expunged from the Register Book with a Red Line (—) indicating non-compliance with the Society's Rules.

The Owners have been informed accordingly.
