With reference to Mr. Turnbull's letter of the 19th instant, enclosing one from the Owners of the steamer "OAKGROVE" intimating that they are transferring this vessel's class to the British Corporation, I have now to inform you that the case was submitted to the Sub-Committee of Classification at their meeting today, who, in all the circumstances, have had no alternative but to give instructions for the vessel's class to be expunged from the Register Book with a Red Line, indicating non-compliance with the Society's Rules.
