
Dear Mr. Lavers,

I am in receipt of your letter of the 28th ultimo, returning the freeboard computation and certificate for the S.S. "HEINAN MARU", of Mitsugahama. This vessel is classed in our Register Book 100 A1 "Shelter Deck", and although to all intents and purposes the shelter deck is the upper deck, in this case the vessel is described in our Register Book and classification certificates as a shelter deck vessel, and consequently the freeboard is given as measured from that deck, the vessel, although being classed under our shelter deck rules, being equivalent to the standard for Table A freeboard. You will find a considerable number of similar cases.

I return the computation and certificate herewith.
