I have to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 18th instant respecting the case of your steamer "AGIOS VLASIOS", which I note is now loading in Cuba, and that you desire the Committee's approval for postponing the Second Special Survey No.2 and repairs until her arrival at Piraeus. I think it well to point out that the year of grace allowed for the completion of the survey in question expires at the end of this month, and in view of the extensive damage which the vessel was found to have sustained, when in drydock at Leghorn in October last, following her stranding at Hutter Bar Sanso, it should have been clear to you, after the communication which was made to Messrs. Rethymnis & Kulukundis, Ltd., on the 3rd December last, that you should have made definite arrangements for the Special Survey and the necessary repairs to have been effected before the end of this month, when the year of grace which the Committee had granted for the completion of the survey expires.
