I have to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 19th instant respecting the case of the steam trawler "ALBERIC" referred to in Liverpool report No. 107140, which, in view of the letter which you have received from the Owners asking for a further postponement in connection with the completion of the 2nd Special Survey No. 3, has been referred for the consideration of the General Committee.

The case was considered by the General Committee at their Meeting today, at which the full facts were reported, and they regret that in all the circumstances, they could not see their way to granting the further extension of three months which the Owners requested to complete the necessary repairs, and they accordingly have had no alternative but to give instructions for the vessel's class to be expunged from the Register.

I enclose for your information a copy of the letter which has been addressed to the Owners conveying this decision.
