S. With reference to the classification in the Society's Register Book of the steamer trawler "ALBERIC", I beg to inform you that your letter of the 18th instant addressed to the Society's Liverpool Office has been forwarded to this Office, together with a report of the examination recently made of this vessel afloat, by the Society's Surveyor at Fleetwood in connection with the advancement of the very much overdue 2nd Special Survey No.3.

With regard thereto, I have to inform you that the case has been carefully considered by the General Committee at their Meeting today, and having regard to the various postponements which have been granted after repeated promises which you have given that the remaining items of the Special Survey and the necessary repairs would be carried out, the Committee regret that they are unable to agree to any further postponement, especially as the year of grace allowed for the completion of the Survey expired so long ago
