Dear Sir,

S. I beg to acquaint you that the Society's Surveyors at Oslo have forwarded to this Office your letter of the 19th ultimo, from which it is observed that you have now decided to transfer the classification of your steamer "HELLE" to the Norske Veritas.

With regard thereto you will remember that at your request the Committee, in December, 1934, agreed to the Second Special Survey No.1, which was then due, being postponed on the definite understanding that it would be completed in all respects within the year of grace allowed by the Society's Rules.

As this period has now expired, and the vessel has not been submitted for survey, as promised, the Committee have had no alternative but to give instructions for the vessel's class to be expunged from the Register Book with a Red Line, indicating non-compliance with the Society's Rules.
