The Oslo Surveyors report this vessel placed on floating dock, minor repairs effected and the bottom coated.

Some rivets in coal bunkers have been temporarily repaired by electric welding and the Surveyors recommend these rivets and a number of wasted shell rivets in coal bunker be renewed at the next dry docking.

The engine seating has been renewed, a new engine having been fitted.

It is submitted the vessel appears worthy to remain as classed with record of survey 4,33 subject as recommended.
