The First Special Survey No.1 became due on each of these barges in February, 1934.

In April last the Committee agreed to a proposal to hold the outstanding surveys within the year of grace, and on the 13th ultimo they approved a further postponement of the surveys until the middle of the present month, when, it was stated by the Owners, the barges would be placed on the slipway at Civitavecchia.

The Society's Genoa Surveyors now write, forwarding a copy of a letter from the Owners, to the effect that on account of the present situation and circumstances beyond their control they are forced to suspend the class of these vessels with this Society.

The Classing Committee had the cases before them on Friday, the 10th instant, when, in the circumstances, they decided to give instructions for the vessels' characters to be withdrawn from the Register Book and three dots (. . .) inserted in each case, indicating withdrawal of class at Owners' request.
