F. With reference to the Load Line Certificate issued by this Society on the 17th February, 1933, a copy of which has been forwarded to you, in respect of the steam tug "EMILIA" valid until the 17th February, 1938, I am directed to acquaint you that in reply to enquiry regarding the Annual Survey, which will become due on the 17th instant, I am informed by the Admiralty that as this vessel (now renamed "EMILY") will be engaged solely on Dockyard service at Malta the issue of a further Lloyd's freeboard certificate will not be necessary.
