I beg to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 7th instant respecting your steam trawler "JUAN", from which it is noted that you desire, if possible, to retain your ships in class with this Society.

Since the despatch of your letter under reply, you will have received mine of the 9th instant, in which it was stated that the Society's Surveyor at Cadiz had been informed by your representative (your son) that you did not intend to continue the class of the vessel above referred to, and that in consequence her character has been withdrawn from the Society's Register Book and three dots (...) inserted in lieu thereof.

I may say that the Society's Surveyor at Cadiz, when writing under the date of 31st ultimo, also mentioned the fact that repairs were being carried out, but he anticipated that the work in hand would not satisfy all the requirements of this Society.

You are no doubt aware that the vessel became due for the Second Special Survey No.1 in June this year, and if you wish the vessel's class to be reinstated it would be
