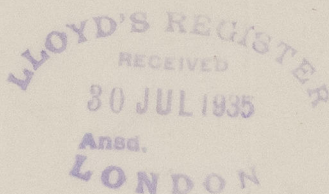

Dear Sir,

With reference to the case of the steam trawler "Juan" and your letter of the 4th instant, I have to inform you that I have spoken to the sons of the Owner regarding the continuing of the class of this vessel and I have been informed by them that the matter is being considered by the Owner in Coruña, and that I would be informed in due course, of his decision.

Up to the present I have not heard anything further, and as the repairs are considerably advanced, I think it would be advisable for you to communicate direct with the Owner in Coruña.

I have informed the Owner's son of the notes in the Special Reasons List and the Limitation List, but nothing has been done yet to the boiler.
