The First Special Survey No.3 became due on
this vessel in March, 1934.

Action has been deferred from time to time,
and when the case received consideration in April last, a
proposal to extend the class for six months beyond the year
of grace was agreed to.

In reply to enquiry the Owners state they
understand the vessel is at present laid up at Curacao, and
in view of the extensive repairs required for reclassification
it has been decided not to repair her. They therefore request
that the class may be withdrawn.

The Classing Committee had the case before them
on Friday, the 1st instant, when in the circumstances they
decided to give instructions for the vessel's class to be
withdrawn from the Register Book and three dots (...) ^{11,35}
inserted in lieu thereof, indicating withdrawal of class
Owners' request.
