H. Reverting to my letter of the 26th February last relative to the steamer "PRESIDENT GOMEZ", I beg to inform you that under a recent alteration in the Society's Rules kedge anchors are no longer required to be supplied to vessels classed with this Society.

With regard to the stream anchor it is being suggested to the Owners that arrangements might be made for this anchor to be examined at the first convenient opportunity on the vessel's call at a port where there is a Surveyor to this Society stationed. In the circumstances it will not be necessary for the Committee to avail themselves of your good offices in this case.
