With reference to the call here on the 24th instant of one of your Representatives regarding the outstanding question relating to the stream and kedge anchors of the steamer "PRESIDENT GOMEZ", I think it well to point out that under a recent alteration in the Society's Rules, kedge anchors are no longer required to be supplied to vessels classed with this Society.

As regards the stream anchor which should be submitted for inspection by one of the Society's Surveyors so as to put the equipment in order, it is suggested that arrangements should be made for this to be done at the first convenient opportunity upon the vessel's call at a port where there is a Surveyor to the Society stationed.
