The Third Special Survey No.1 became due on this vessel in March, 1934.

The vessel has been laid up since 1931, and action in regard to the Boiler Survey, Screwshaft Survey and Third Special Survey No.1 has been deferred from time to time, the usual undertaking being furnished in May, 1935.

In June last the Committee had the case under consideration, the Special Survey being more than two years overdue, and the Society's Vancouver Surveyor was requested to arrange with the Owners for a general examination to be made of the vessel.

In reply to this request the Vancouver Surveyor now writes that the Owners have decided to dismantle the fittings of the vessel which might be of use in other vessels, as they do not intend to run her again. They state the hull will probably be sold for scrap.

The year of grace expired in March 1935.

The Classing Committee had the case before them on Tuesday, the 8th instant, when, in all the circumstances, they decided to give instructions for the vessel's character to be withdrawn from the Register Book and three dots (. . .) inserted in lieu thereof, indicating withdrawal of class at Owners' request.
