Sir,

I have to acquaint you that in connexion with an  
D. action pending between the Owners and Builders of the s.s. "CAMOSUN  
(No. 210 in the Register Book), this Society has been called  
upon to produce all documents, or copies of documents, which  
have passed between the Society, or its Surveyors, and the  
Owners, so far as regards the vessel and the damage she is  
alleged to have sustained on the voyage from this country in  
the early part of 1905, and the repairs subsequently carried  
out at your port.

On the production of your report of June, 1905, the  
Society's attention was called to a print of some damage survey  
reports dated 19th, 20th and 26th May and 15th June, 1905,  
which one of the parties connected with the case stated to  
have been issued by you. No copies of these reports, however,  
appear to have been received from you at this Office, and in  
the circumstances I have to request that you will be good  
enough to state if such reports were issued by you to the Owners
