We regret having to trouble you further in this matter.

On 13th inst., at the diet before the Commissioner, Sheriff Thomson, your Mr. Warlow produced all the documents said to be in your possession falling under our clients' diligence. At the same diet we had cited the Plaintiffs' Glasgow Agents similarly to produce all documents in their possession. Among the documents produced by them were prints of Survey Reports of date 19th and 26th May 1905 by Mr. Metcalfe, your Surveyor at San Francisco, along with relative recommendations by him, which we enclose for reference. These appear to have been produced in the previous proceedings in this action.

The only Report Mr. Warlow produced from San Francisco is by Mr. Metcalfe, and is dated 17th June 1905. We shall, therefore, feel/
