Dear Mr. Warlow,

I confirm the telegrams which have passed between us to-day respecting the case of the s.s. "CAMOSUN":-

RECEIVED:- "Camosun suggest you also send me First Entry Reports see clause 7A specification of documents.

SENT:- "Clause 7A reads "All reports of survey obtained by the pursuers" First Entry reports were not so obtained. Think therefore specification does not cover these documents".

RECEIVED:- "Camosun many thanks I agree with your reading of clause 7 But subpoena specially mentions Reports on original construction hull, machinery, electric light and others as per specification Sheriff sits Tuesday for this case".

You will understand of course that there is no desire on our part to even appear to be putting any obstacle in the way of the Court in the inquiry into the case of this vessel, but the First Entry reports are certainly not included in the description of the documents mentioned in the specification.

In view, however, of your intimation regarding the contents of the subpoena served upon you we are sending the First Entry reports to-night officially.
