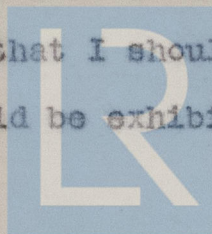

Sir,

I have to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 8th instant, enclosing one from Messrs. Wright, Johnston & Mackenzie, Solicitors, with regard to the case pending between the Union Steamship Company of British Columbia, Ltd., and Messrs. Bow, McLachlan & Co., Ltd., in the matter of the S.S. "CAMOSUN".

The Committee have no wish to place any obstacle in the way of the production of any documents in the Society's possession respecting this vessel on the receipt of the necessary legal citation, and I have therefore to send you herewith the report made on this vessel by this Society's Surveyor at San Francisco in June, 1905, together with the papers attached thereto, all of which you will be at liberty to produce in court when the above mentioned summons has been served upon you. To complete the case I am having prepared a copy of the First Entry certificate issued for the vessel, which will be sent to you as soon as it is ready.
